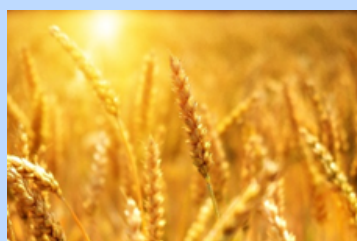
PUMPKIN PICKING

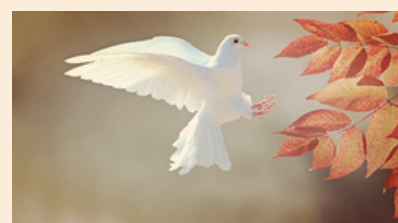
Prayers for Peace and Justice Sunday 11th October:

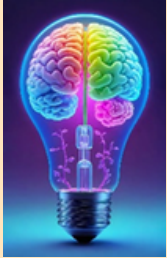

PAINTINGS – SERIES ON JUDGES

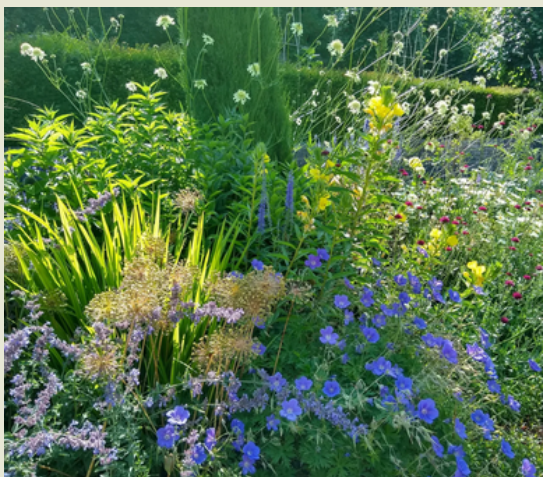
