
PANCAKE PARTY! 3-4PM TUESDAY 17TH FEBRUARY


ASH WEDNESDAY - 10AM 18TH FEBRUARY

Take time out for quiet reflection.


BORDERING ON INSANITY- CREATING AN ALL-YEAR-ROUND BORDER (7:30PM WED. 18TH MARCH)



Henton & District Gardening Club welcomes speaker Timothy Walker, lecturer, botanist, gardener and author, who was for many years the director of the Oxford Botanic Garden. Amongst many other things, he has won a clutch of medals at The Chelsea Flower Show. Since 2014, he has been a Senior Lecturer and tutor in Plant Biology at Somerville College, Oxford. This talk looks exclusively at the herbaceous border he created with his wife, over 25 years. It covers the principles and practicalities that were adopted in an attempt to create a border that is interesting all-year-round.
